They have proven effectiveness in real-world disaster scenarios such as hurricanes and FEMA/CAP regional exercises. In addition, they support diverse operations such as blood collection and transport and disaster response, including hurricane, fire, tornado, and flood.

Through this partnership, Civil Air Patrol (CAP) can provide distributive communications and staffing resources during disasters and other emergencies to FEMA, the Department of Defense, state emergency management command and control nodes, hospitals and emergency medical services, public health and other health system nodes, first-responder coordination centers, as well as other emergency support function/disaster recovery function (ESF/DRF) stakeholder communication sites. More importantly, it provides CAP with a simple, standardized communication system, linking all its vehicles,

aircraft, and command and control nodes/staging areas under a single responsive and tested/demonstrated system to support its response and the ESF/DRF partners, as mentioned above.
